

## Consecration Week 2025 – Day 1

Let's discuss Holy Spirit as a Person.

My perspective of relating to God changed when I learned that Holy Spirit is a person.

For years, we referred to Him as "The" Holy Spirit. But I do not hear anyone referring to me as "the" Andrew Jagessar. I am called Andrew Jagessar because I have a visible, noticeable body. Likewise, Holy Spirit has a unique body. His body is The Church, and we are the sacred carriers of His Presence and Power.

We must train ourselves to relate to Holy Spirit as a person. He is relational and He is relatable. He is extremely concerned about your total well-being.

In Luke 3, Jesus approaches John the Baptist by the river Jordan to be baptized in water. After His baptism, Holy Spirit descends bodily on Jesus and a voice from above declares that He, Jesus, is pleasing His Father to absolute perfection.

What does this mean to us and why would Holy Spirit lead Dr. Luke to record this moment?

Ponder these points as we journey through Day 1 of Consecration Week 2025 with The Person of Holy Spirit:

1. **Spiritual Sonship** - When Holy Spirit is allowed to **operate**, His first order is spiritual adoption. He completes the process of adopting you into The Family of God as a direct descendant or a child. You are a child of God when you are under the **influence** of Holy Spirit.

2. **Spiritual Citizenship** - When Holy Spirit is allowed to **dominate**, He puts the nature of The King into you. You are no longer subjected to serve the devil, you are now a citizen of The Kingdom of God. Your life's mission is to carry out The King's Mission in His Mission Field. You are a citizen of The Kingdom of God when you are under the **inspiration** of Holy Spirit.

3. **Spiritual Worship** - When Holy Spirit is allowed to **illuminate**, He brings you into The Presence of The King, making you into a worshipper. Worship

is about worth. How do you value The Person of Holy Spirit? You become what you worship. Holy Spirit will never separate you from Jesus. His job is to constantly remind you that Jesus is the one Father has sent as His Beloved. We are pleasing our Heavenly Father when we worship His Son. We become like Jesus when we worship Him. You are a spiritual worshipper when you are under the **direction** of Holy Spirit.

**Luke 3:21-22 (Amplified)**

***Now when all the people were baptized, and when Jesus also had been baptized, and [while He was still] praying, the [visible] heaven was opened***

***And the Holy Spirit descended upon Him in bodily form like a dove, and a voice came from heaven, saying, You are My Son, My Beloved! In You I am well pleased and find delight!***

So today, press on in Prayer, Fasting, and The Word. Invest time with Jesus. When you do, you will realize that Holy Spirit was up to this all along.
