

Consecration Week 2025 – Day 2

We pray that you are Building The Habits of The Consecrated Life.

Let's look at what it means to be "FULL" of Holy Spirit.

According to my recollection of earlier days as a believer, I was taught that being full of Him is to be able to speak in tongues and pray with the understanding and with the language of Holy Spirit. While this is true, there is more to being "FULL" of His Spirit.

Let's do some drilling and some digging into The Word.

We are going to Luke 4:1 and 14:

*Now Jesus, **full of [and in perfect communication with] the Holy Spirit, returned from the Jordan and was led by the Spirit in the wilderness***

*Then Jesus went back to Galilee **in the power** of the Spirit, and the news about Him spread through the entire region.*

While we are flawed, finite, and unfinished, He is perfect. He is also ready to have perfect communication with us. We can be full of Him even when we do not understand everything about Him. Just communicate with Him, and you will see the difference.

Being full of Holy Spirit means:

1. We Listen to Him - Jesus' earthly life teaches us mostly about listening. An example of this is His baptism in water. The Messiah didn't have to be baptized, but people needed to know that water baptism seals the born-again experience. John The Baptist had to take Jesus into the waters of baptism to set the right pattern for us. Jesus submitted, to indicate to us that He was listening to Holy Spirit, and so can we.

2. We are Led by Him - The next phase of Jesus' journey is troubling. He is being led by His Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted, tested, and tried. This moment was not about Him alone, it was also great news for those who will be "in" Jesus. His Spirit took Him to where He we find ourselves very often. He went to where we are so that sin and satan can be

defeated for us. As children of God, we are led by His Spirit through the vicious storm and into victory.

3. We Latch on to Him - We can produce a long list of those who gave up too soon, quite too quickly, and went into early spiritual retirement. We can also produce an even longer list of those who latched on, held on, kept on, prayed on, believed on, and experienced His Power. Jesus overcame so that you can overcome. Your breakthrough is here. Latch on to Holy Spirit and never let go.

4. We Live in Him - Not only is Holy Spirit in us, but we are also in Him. We move when He moves. We speak when, and whatever He speaks. We love what He loves. Jesus left Lower Galilee as a submissive and simple son of Mary, BUT He returned in The Power of His Spirit. We can live in The Power of Holy Spirit when we Live in Him. He defines us. He refines us. He untwines us. He works on us, in us, and through us, when we Live in Him.

5. We Lead others to Him - History is truly His Story. He left Nazareth as a student. He returns a Teacher. He left Nazareth as a searching man. He returns to Nazareth as The Sent Messiah. Our life's Mission is entirely about leading others to Him. Leading others to Jesus is proof that we are full of His Spirit.

We have a great opportunity to enter into perfect communication with Holy Spirit. We can be "FULL" of Him.
