

## Consecration Week 2025 – Day 3

What does it mean to “anoint” someone? Is there a difference between the anointing carried by Jesus and those who believe in, live for, and follow Him as The Messiah?

Let’s drill into our discussion for Day 3 of this great week.

In Luke 4, Jesus is in Nazareth, attending Sabbath Sessions. It is His turn to read from the writings of Prophets of the past. This portion of Isaiah 61, though read many times by multiple people, was never read by The Anointed One, The Messiah. Jesus, being The Word, reads this and stops before vengeance, judgment, and the coming restoration of Israel. He closes The Scroll and declares that this Messianic and Prophetic piece is fulfilled today. Now, you will truly need to be the “anointed” one to deal with the repercussions of such a claim.

### **Luke 4:18-19**

*The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, because He has **anointed** Me  
to **preach the gospel** to the poor;  
He has sent Me to **heal** the brokenhearted, to  
**proclaim liberty** to the captives and  
**recovery of sight** to the blind,  
to **set at liberty** those who are oppressed;  
To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord.*

In our text, Jesus is claiming to be The Messiah and the Fulfillment of every prophetic utterance about the Messiah. He is also proclaiming His followers to be carriers of His Anointing. This will upset all of hell’s agenda.

**Do you know that you are anointed to do all that Jesus did? You are the extension of His expression to this planet. You are the Light of God who will dispel the darkness. You are His Light because He Lives in you. You are anointed with His Anointing.**

Without the Anointed One and His Anointing in our lives, sin will be our greatest obstacle and obstruction, and we will miss great opportunities.

Here are the areas Jesus delivered us from so that we can function in His Anointing:

1. **FROM POVERTY TO PROSPERITY** (*The Poor*) – Without Jesus, The Messiah, we are spiritually impoverished and bankrupt. The Anointed One and His Anointing grants us the greatest news called The Gospel. We are anointed to come into a lifestyle of overflow, abundance and eternal life.
2. **FROM PIECES TO POWER** (*The Brokenhearted*) – Jesus is the healer of every brokenness. He can even heal a broken heart. His Anointing empowers. Shattered dreams, weakened vision, and bruised areas can be made whole. Even the mistakes that brought about the pain can be dealt with.
3. **FROM PRISON TO PARDON** (*The Captives*) – There is no freedom without Jesus. Deliverance from the deadly grip of sin and satan is possible. Many are held captive in their thinking. Stinking thinking stinks. The Anointed One is proclaiming our pardon today. Liberty and deliverance are functions of The Anointing, and we are the beneficiaries.
4. **FROM PINNED TO PERSPECTIVE** (*The Blind*) – We are pinned down when we are spiritually or naturally blind. Jesus, the Anointed One, came to restore the spiritual, moral, and physical sight. We can reclaim our Vision.
5. **FROM PENALTY TO PROMISE** (*The Bruised*) – Sin has a crushing effect on our lives. The pain of being alienated from God and His Presence is caused by bruises that hijack our praise. Jesus our Messiah, is anointed to release us from every bondage and bring us out of every oppressing, tormenting, and debilitating trick of the devil. We are justified.
